

## **The Word of God**

### **John 1:9-13 (ESV)**

<sup>9</sup> The true light, which gives light to everyone, was coming into the world. <sup>10</sup> He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world did not know him. <sup>11</sup> He came to his own, and his own people did not receive him. <sup>12</sup> But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, <sup>13</sup> who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.

#### **The true light:**

In this Gospel of John, "truth" and "true" are often employed to signify what is everlasting or heavenly, as opposed to the merely temporal or earthly.

#### **Did not receive him:**

Jesus' public ministry was one of rejection by "his own people"

#### **Become children of God:**

Fallen human beings are not children of God by nature; this is the privilege only of those who have faith, a faith generated in them by the sovereign action of God

#### **Who were born:**

This new birth takes place by the action of the Spirit giving life to those who were dead in trespasses and sins.
